WHY THIS MATTERS

A legal entity, recognizable practice name and provider identity can all be valid at once. The job is to preserve the relationships so patients and payers do not mistake one for another.



PRIORITY FINDINGS

What the public footprint suggests

These are sample discrepancies for the visual MVP. A production report would retain the source URL, checked date, observed value and evidence image for each finding.



NPPEs

Former organization relationship

The individual provider record appears current, while the organization relationship still points to a prior practice.

HIGH

Guided organization filing



CARE COMPARE

Former Scottsdale service location

The patient-facing Medicare profile appears to retain a location the office says is no longer active.

HIGH

Enrollment roadmap



CMS PROVIDER DATA

Group and location signals disagree

Public enrollment-derived data does not fully match the office-approved organization and current Phoenix location.

HIGH

Evidence review



CITY SELECT

Only the legal LLC is discoverable

The legal entity is valid, but the recognizable practice name is not consistently connected to it in public search.

MEDIUM

Direct correction



PRACTICE WEBSITE

Insurance list omits active plans

The owned website does not show two plans the sample practice says are currently accepted.

THE SHORTEST RESPONSIBLE PATH

Every fix has an owner

Provider Control does not promise a fictional sync-everywhere button. It organizes the evidence, approval and legitimate entry point for each system.

Confirm organization, location, practice name and patient phone.

Prepare the current organization details and authorized filing sequence.
